**Peter Kneen** is a pioneer in the field of lightweight structures with numerous space-frames, fabric structures, cable net structures and shade structures to his credit. He was a founding member of the MSA, the precursor to the expanded LSAA.

During a 25 year stint at the University of New South Wales he was the first academic to be promoted on the basis of industry input and leading design work. Notable projects include the design of the spire of the Victorian Arts Centre and the Parque Anhembi Exhibition building in Sao Paulo. He performed a design check on the Millennium Dome in London and investigated problems with the Commonwealth Games stadium roof in Malaysia.

The education of both engineers and architects in the effective use of structural form, appropriate materials and computer technology is an ongoing passion.
